

Maintenance, Electrical and Operational Safety Questions

Slot Machine Maintenance Safety Questions

- Is there a safety committee for the slot supervisor and slot technicians to be a part of or to report to regarding maintenance issues?
- Are maintenance safety objectives reinforced throughout the casino?
- Are there daily maintenance inspections?
- Is there a chain-of-command for line employees to advise supervisors for any maintenance safety issues?

Slot Machine Electrical Safety Questions

- Does your facility have bare bulbs, exposed wiring, outlet/junction box cover plates missing, altered circuit breaker panels, or unlabeled electrical panels?
- Are power strips UL-listed and plugged directly into permanent outlets?
- Are extension cords being utilized in lieu of permanent wiring?
- Are extension cords plugged directly into permanent outlets?
- Are extension cords and power strips allowed to run through walls ceilings, floors, and doorways or under rugs?
- Is there a clearance of at least 36 inches in front of all electrical panels near slot machines?
- Do all panels and electrical boxes for slot machines have covers - with no exposed electrical wiring?

Slot Machine Operational Safety Questions

- Is the repair work being performed in a safe manner for prevention of accidents to other slot technicians, fellow workers, the general public and casino property?
- Is there extensive operational safety training for all employees?
- Are there good operational safety practices followed by all employees?
- Is there immediate and appropriate corrective action for any violations of any operational safety rules?
